Originally published in 1972 for his children, Jack Moore's Avon Almanac is a vivid evocation of his childhood in the Warwickshire village of Bidford-on-Avon during the 1920s.The format Moore adopts is a year of 'walks to school' in Bidford through the changing seasons from three diverse outlying parts of the parish.

In this new edition, made generally available for the first time, Jack's account is enriched by supportive detail about the period and the village's inhabitants, a glossary of agricultural and dialect terms and extensive illustrations and maps of the area.

The launch will feature selected readings from the book interspersed with a topical mixture of folk music by Richard Churchley and songs from William Edwards which will seek to take us back to a bygone era when agriculture was the dominant industry, the village shops catered for virtually all daily needs and cars were a rarity ...
